**Notes from the Pastor**

I received questions about the insert we put in the bulletin this past weekend. The people asking or commenting were not being negative about the insert, they just thought it might be a good idea to let people know what we have or will be spending the extra money on in the future. This listing is not meant to be all inclusive, but is simply a demonstration of what kinds of things we are spending some of these extra dollars on. First of all, the faculty and staff of both the schools received a 1% raise for this coming year. A portion of that is covered by our increased giving. Our parish staff also received the same 1% raise. While we did have some generous benefactors who helped pay for the books we gave out a Christmas and Easter, as well as helping pay for some of FORMED.ORG, the parish also covers a portion of those costs. So the majority of our funds end up going for spiritual enrichment and education. There is also simple upkeep and maintenance of the parish grounds and structures. In addition we would like to keep building an account that can be used for general upkeep and emergency expenditures so every time something breaks we don't have to wonder if we have funds to cover that expense.
