## NOTES FROM THE PASTOR

We will have a communal celebration of the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick on Sunday March 3<sup>rd</sup> beginning at 3:00 p.m. We encourage those who are elderly, and feel the burden of years, to avail themselves of this sacrament. In addition we encourage those who have chronic illnesses that have diminished their overall health, or those who are seriously ill with other health issues such as cancer, Parkinson's, diabetes, heart disease etc., to make use of this sacrament. This sacrament is generally not considered to be used by those who simply have the common cold or flu or other common ailments that are temporary and not considered serious to the overall diminishment of your health. To be clear, we do not ask people what their ailment is, or proof of the seriousness nature of their illness, so anyone who wishes to come forward will receive the sacrament.

Family members of the person who is receiving the anointing are certainly encouraged to come and join in the prayers for their loved one. The prayerful support of family is an important element of the healing process that comes through God's Grace.
