I want to take this occasion to say again that I am truly appreciative of all the words of condolence and assurances of prayer for me and my family upon the death of my mom. It is truly humbling, and one of the great blessings of the priesthood, to have so many people who share their concern for us when we are suffering or in grief. I also greatly appreciate the many prayers that have been offered for my mom's soul. If we go to purgatory, we will end up in heaven, after the purification of our souls has taken place. So please, keep praying for mom, and for any other poor souls in purgatory. Also know that if indeed my mom is already in heaven that your prayers will not be wasted, they will be applied for whoever is in most need of God's mercy.
