## NOTES FROM THE PASTOR

A brief update about how our *“Preserving Our Past...Brightening Our Future”* capital campaign is going. First of all, let me say thank you for the most important aspect of this campaign, all the prayers that have been said. Without prayer nothing can be considered successful, so thank you and please continue to pray for the success of our renovation project. If you recall, we kicked off our campaign the weekend of June 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> with parish volunteers delivering pledge request packets to homes, those that we were not able to deliver personally were sent through the mail. The following week, the volunteers returned to the homes they delivered to and retrieved pledge packets, or people brought them into the office themselves, mailed them back in or dropped them in the collection basket. Thus we had a good initial return of gifts and pledges which were processed. In the weeks since we have continued to have pledge packets returned and processed. Up to this point, we have \$2,174,042.00 committed to the project. We are very excited about the amount of support we have seen thus far and we know that there are many pledge cards that are still being prayed over and considered for return in the near future. Again, thank you to all who have returned their pledge packets and may God bless us all as we continue to move toward the goal of enhancing the wonderful worship space we already have.
