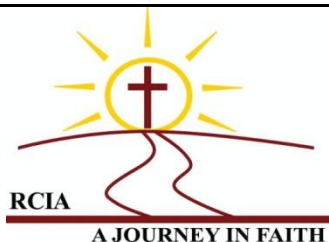
## NOTES FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

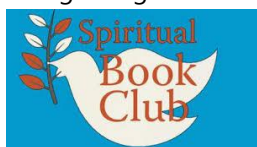
## PARISH NEWS

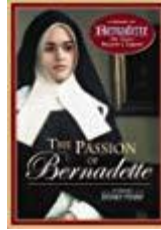
### CALLING ALL CATHOLIC WOMEN:
